Check-in at YMCA North- June 8th line up starts @9:30 pm until 10:30 doors will lock and you will not be permitted in.
Event ends @ 5:00am June-9th for kids needing to be picked by a parent be in the YMCA parking lot after 5:00am.

- Graduates will be provided with a bag, so please only bring a small purse type bag, phone, wallet, swimsuit & towel. No Backpacks permitted. Students will be searched by a NC Senior All-Nighter volunteer prior to entering. Please have your ticket purchase (email) or receipt ready and open when you get in line. You will proceed to the check in line by last name and will be checked in to ensure your ticket purchase, liability release & emergency contact information is on file.
- If anyone arrives under the influence of alcohol/drugs or in their possession, they will not be allowed into the YMCA and their ticket is forfeited. We will contact students, emergency contact but will not be responsible for transportation from YMCA once their admission is revoked.
- NO TOBACCO or VAPING products will be allowed at any time during the event.
- All bags will be checked and searched. **REPEAT ALL BAGS WILL BE CHECKED AND SEARCHED!!** You will receive a bag at check in and tagged with a personal number for the night. (This number will be used for the bag check room.)
- Upon arrival at the YMCA, graduates will check their bags into a secure area.
- Once they arrive at YMCA this is a locked in event so no attendee will be allowed back in if they leave – NO EXCEPTIONS. We strongly encourage your seniors to stay for the whole event. We really don't want them on the road late at night or early morning. If a student decides to leave, they need to sign out and will not be permitted back in. If student is under 18, they cannot leave without a parent picking them up and signing them out.
- Bring appropriate swimwear (no cut-off allowed) restrictions that need to be known and the student is bringing their own restrictive food, please e-mail ncsanclassof2024@gmail.com
- NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS. There will be plenty provided. There will be caffeine including one energy drink per person available to students. It is up to the student to not partake of the energy drink if it is not permitted.
