#### **Elementary BI | Grades K-6**

Students with IEPs and or 504s whose disabilities adversely impact their behavior and the ability to access the general education classroom.

**Program Model**: Small class setting with individualized support to help students grow academically, behaviorally and socially. Time in class is dependent on student need.

**Enrollment**: Placement Team

Comprehensive Elementary Schools

#### Secondary BI | Grades 7-12

Students with IEPs and or 504s who experience significant behavior challenges that affect their ability to access the general education classroom.

**Program Model**: Secondary students have access to a smaller learning environment that includes high support for social and behavioral support. Time in class is dependent on student need.

**Enrollment**: Placement Team

Comprehensive Secondary Schools

#### Commit Academy | Grades 7-8

Students who have exhausted building level interventions at their home middle school and require targeted supports and additional structures to focus on building social/emotional skills and academic behaviors before high school.

**Program Model**: A personalized learning middle school experience that includes high levels of structured support and mandatory mentoring.

**Enrollment**: Placement Team

#### Excelsior: Atlas Academy | Grades 4-6

Students with IEPs who have significant behavior challenges and have exhausted resources with SPS Special Education Continuum and have the potential to benefit from Integrated wrap around services.

**Program Model**: Individualized educational program rooted in the dimensions of wellness model: Integrated primary health care, behavioral health, social health programming. Student lead; family centered, and team based.

#### Excelsior: Compass Academy | Grades 6-8

Students with IEPs who have significant behavior challenges and have exhausted resources with SPS Special Education Continuum and will benefit from Integrated wrap around services.

**Program Model:** Individualized educational program rooted in the dimensions of wellness model: Integrated primary health care, behavioral health, social health programming. Student lead; family centered, and team based.

**Program Model**: Individualized educational program rooted in the dimensions of wellness model: Integrated primary health care, behavioral health, social health programming. Student lead; family centered, and team based.

#### MAP Academy | Grades 6-12

Students with mental health diagnoses including severe anxiety, depression, suicidal ideation, and childhood schizophrenia.

**Program Model**: Full day program that supports Students with Mental Health

diagnosis in a small structured supportive setting

**Enrollment**: Placement Team

MAP Building

#### Pratt Academy: Core | Grades 9-12

Students who have struggled in the traditional high school model as indicated by attendance, behavior, and academic performance. Students may be credit deficient and display behavior challenges. Students hold the potential to benefit from a smaller personalized learning program.

**Program Model**: Full day personalized learning experience includes competency-based credit retrieval, project-based learning, and blended learning opportunities. Structured setting rooted in building positive relationships and built on the philosophy that all students deserve an education that meets academic, social, and behavioral needs.

**Enrollment**: Choice Application

Pratt Building

#### Pratt Academy: North | Grades 11-12

Students who have struggled in a traditional high school setting as indicated by attendance, behavior, and academic performance and are ready to benefit from vocational/internship opportunities. Student factors include a high number of absences and school disengagement. Programming may be utilized for students who are long-term suspended or expelled to receive educational services.

**Program Model**: ALE program, personalized learning with vocational experiences at both NewTech Skills Center and Community Based Internships.

**Enrollment**: Choice Application

#### On-Track: Flagship Academy | Grades 11-12

Students who are motivated to continue their high school education and are interested in an alternative to a comprehensive high school. Students are typically less than 1 year behind in credits and have a minimal discipline history.

**Program Model**: Personalized learning program that utilizes a blended learning model through Blackboard curriculum shells.
